

Signs of a Vision Problem

Is your child struggling with reading? Did you know that vision problems can interfere with a child's ability to read fluently?



Be on the lookout for these often hidden symptoms of vision problems:

- frequent eye rubbing, blinking, or squinting
- holding reading materials close to the face
- short attention span
- an eye turning in or out
- avoiding reading and other close activities
- seeing double
- frequent headaches
- losing place when reading
- covering one eye
- difficulty remembering what he or she read
- tilting the head to one side
