1. Print pages 2-4 of this PDF, making sure your print settings are set to “landscape” orientation.
2. Cut or fold the bottom of pages 2 and 3 to remove any extra white space.
3. Overlap the pages as indicated by the lighter duplicate strip at the top of pages 3 and 4, then tape or glue together.
4. Hang the *Floss Rule* poster in your desired location and let the learning fun begin!


