

Guides student in the practice of selected reading words in each lesson.			
Teaches appropriate syllable division rules, jobs of Silent E, syllable tags, homophones, and phonograms, as outlined for each lesson.			

Teaches "Leap Words" specific to the lesson.		
Guides student in the completion of the Practice Sheets and/or Warm-up Sheets.		
Teaches vocabulary and activates prior knowledge in story-related lessons.		
Asks pre- and post-reading comprehension questions.
