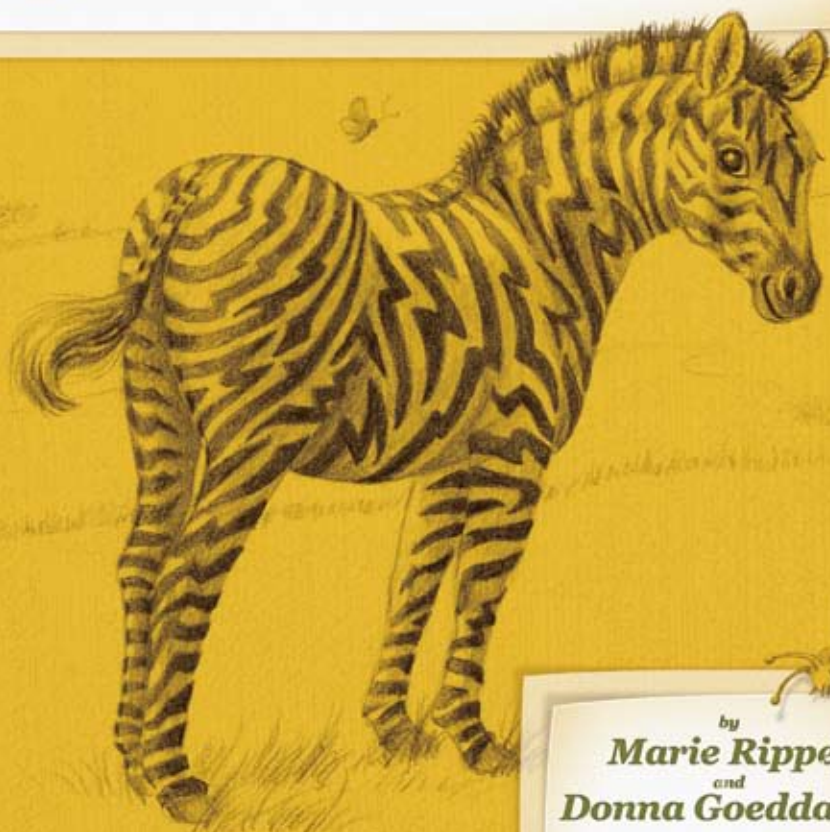

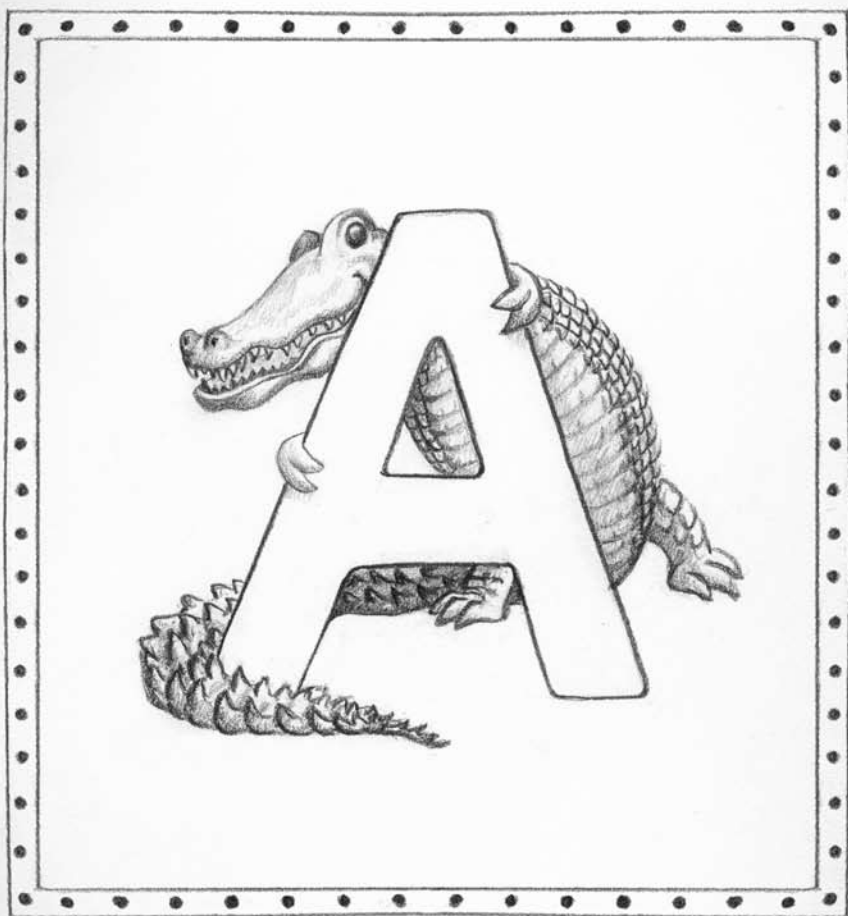

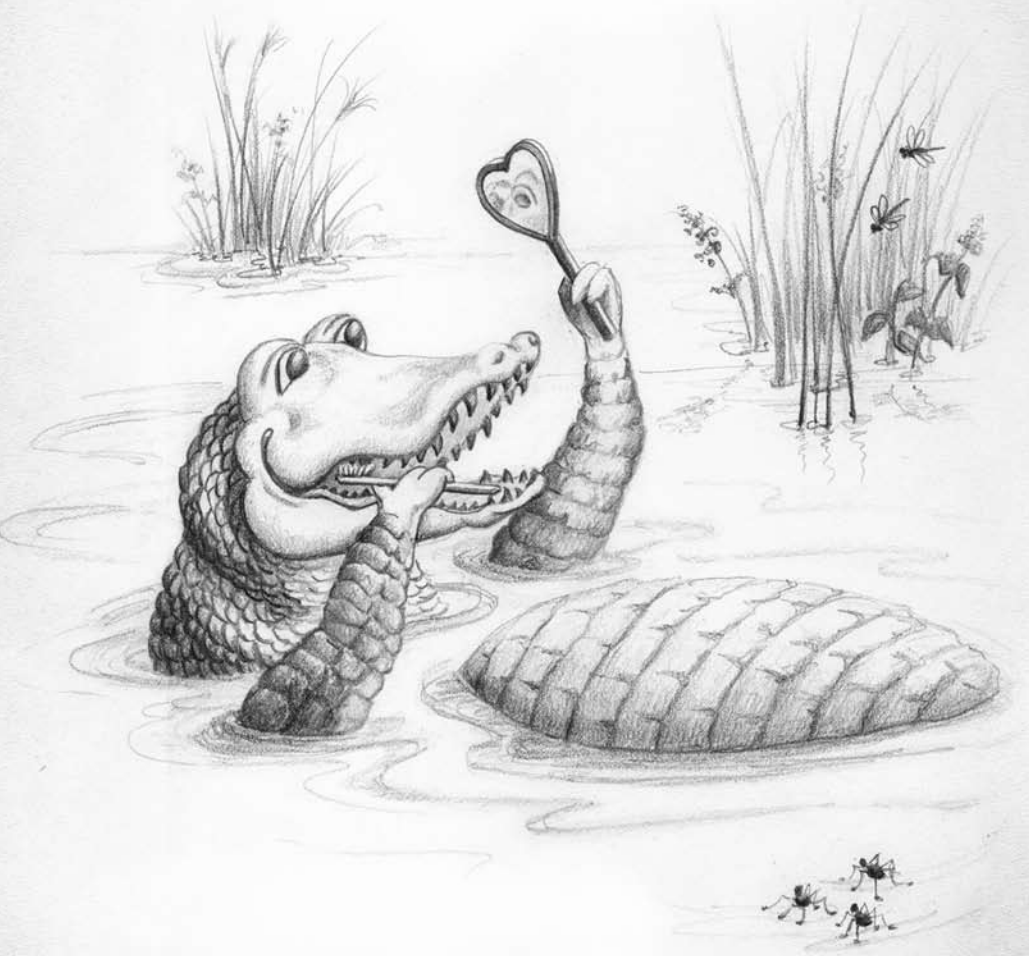




The alligator makes all critters afraid.

Alas! Do you think he brushes?





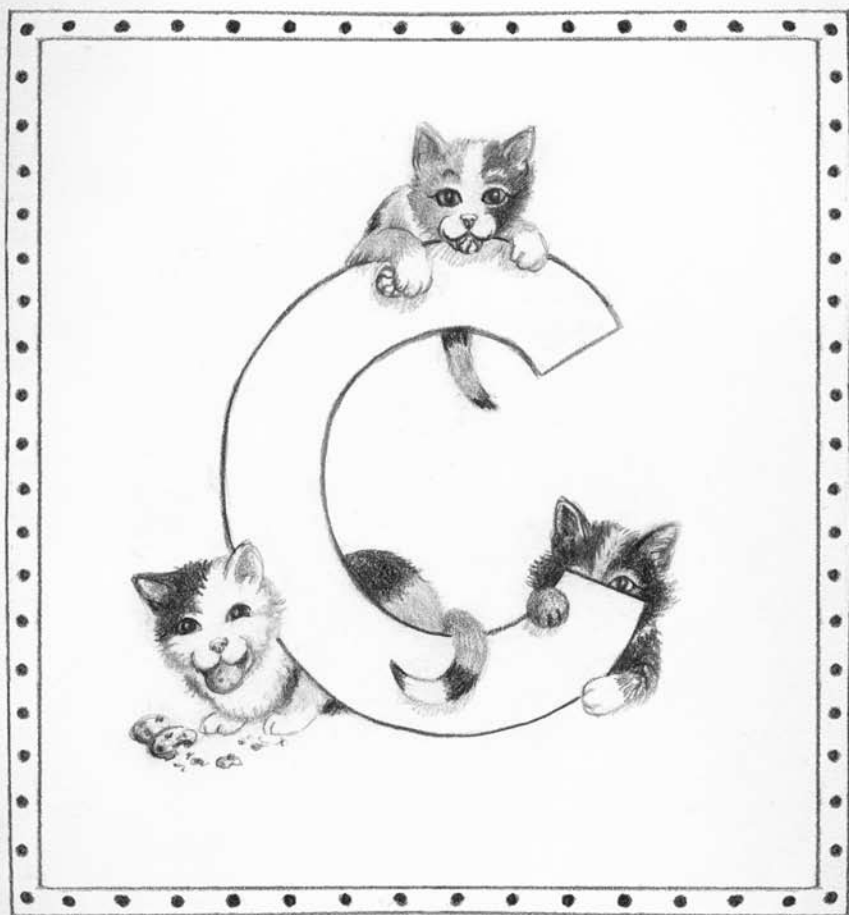
When bears eat blackberries,
