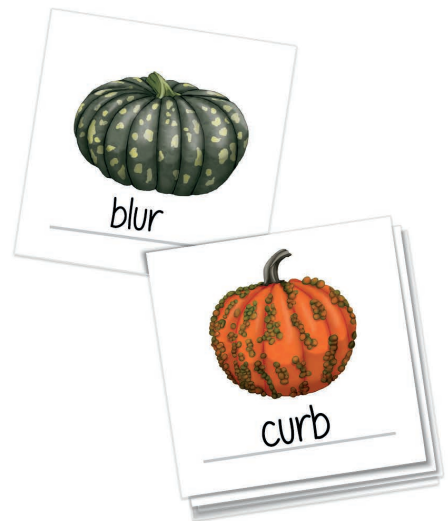


Pumpkin Patch

a reading and spelling review activity



Pumpkin Patch

It's time to pick pumpkins! Let's head to the pumpkin patch!

Instructions for Reading Practice

1. Print the pumpkin patch scene on page 3 and print the pumpkin cards on pages 4-5.
2. Select the appropriate pumpkin cards for your child's level. We've included words from Levels 1-4 of *All About Reading* so that everyone can play!
3. Cut apart the pumpkin cards, mix them up, and place them on the pumpkin patch with the illustrations facing down.
4. Have your child choose a card from the pumpkin patch, then flip it over to reveal what kind of pumpkin they've picked. Have your child read the word on the card. If he reads the word correctly, he may keep the pumpkin he picked.
5. Continue until all the pumpkins have been picked!



Instructions for Spelling Practice

1. Print the pumpkin patch scene on page 3 and print the blank sheet of pumpkin cards on page 6.
2. Cut the cards apart. (For repeat use, laminate the pumpkin cards and use a dry erase marker to write on them.)
3. Have your child select a pumpkin from the pumpkin patch scene. Dictate a word from your child's current spelling lesson (or a review word) and have him write the word on the pumpkin cards. If he spells the word correctly, he may keep the pumpkin he picked.
4. Continue until all the pumpkins have been picked!
