








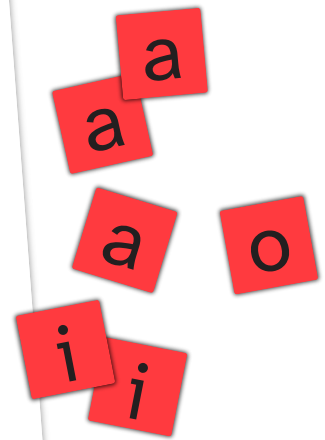

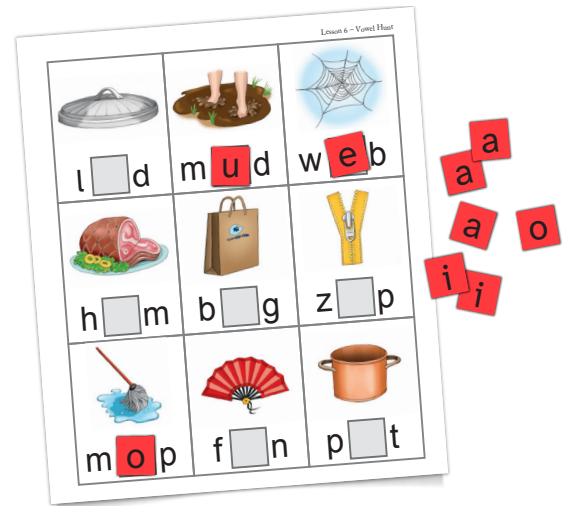


# Vowel Hunt

When a single vowel is followed by a consonant, it usually says its short sound. Let's practice some words with short vowel sounds by having a vowel hunt!

## Prepare the Activity

1. Print the Short Vowel Rule poster on page 4 and keep it handy for use during the activity.
2. Print pages 5-6 and cut out the vowel tiles at the bottom of the pages. Distribute them on the table in front of your student.
3. If desired, print the Word Search on page 7. Set aside.



## How to Play

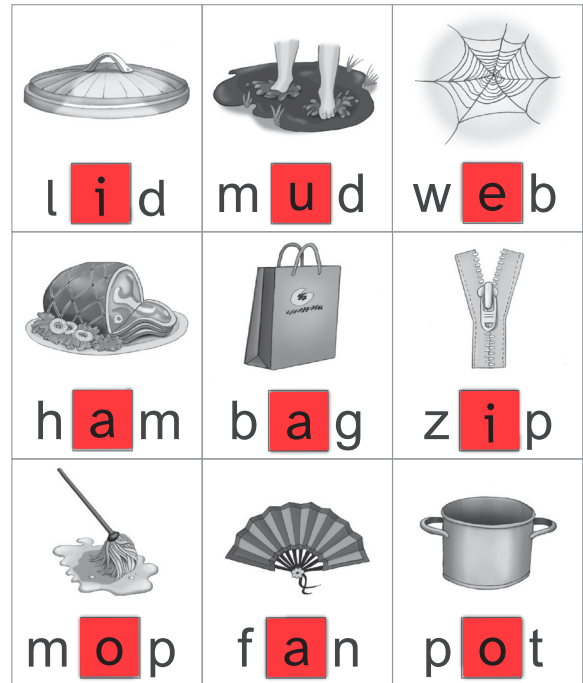
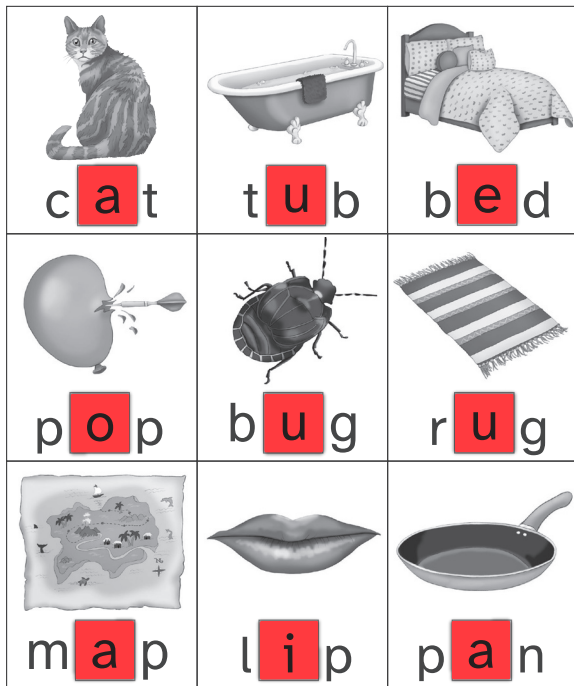
1. Place the Vowel Hunt sheets from pages 5 and 6 in front of your student.
2. Point to the illustration of the first word and dictate what the word should be.
3. Have your student find the vowel that completes the word and either place or glue the letter in the outlined box.
4. Have your student read the finished word, pronouncing the vowel sound slowly and distinctly.
5. Repeat with the rest of the illustrations.

## How to Use the Spelling Poster

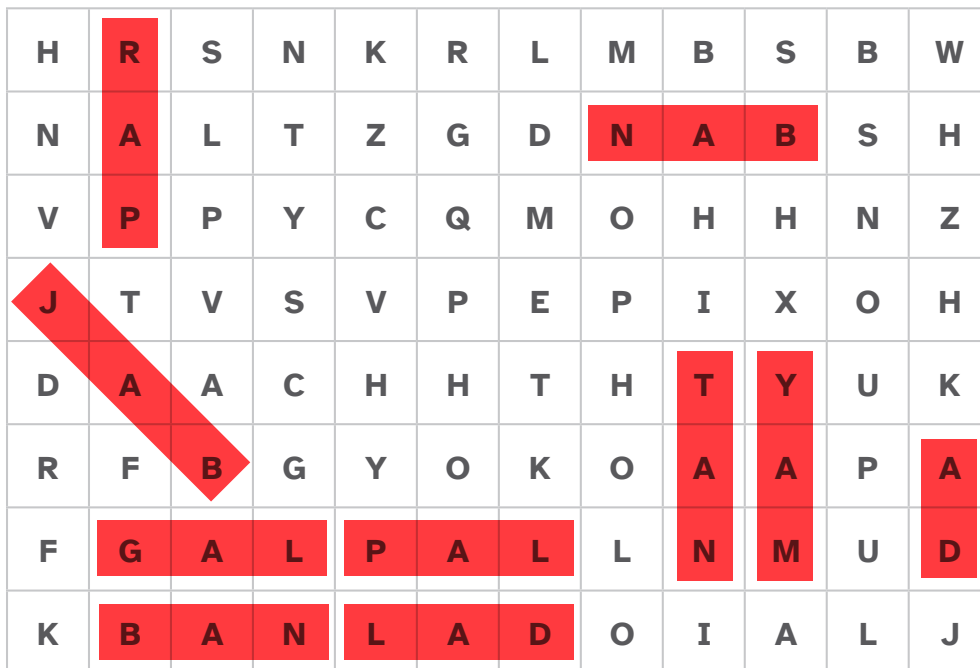
1. Show the Short Vowel Rule poster to your student.
2. Read the sample words aloud and point out the following details: "In each word, the single vowel is followed by a consonant. The vowel is short in each word. A short vowel can be followed by more than one consonant, as in *bell* and *socks*. A short vowel can be at the beginning of the word, as in *and*."
3. You may wish to hang the poster in your lesson area for future reference.

Bonus: Practice with more words using the short vowel *a* by having your student find all the words on the word search from page 7!
