Whisk was glad to have some help.

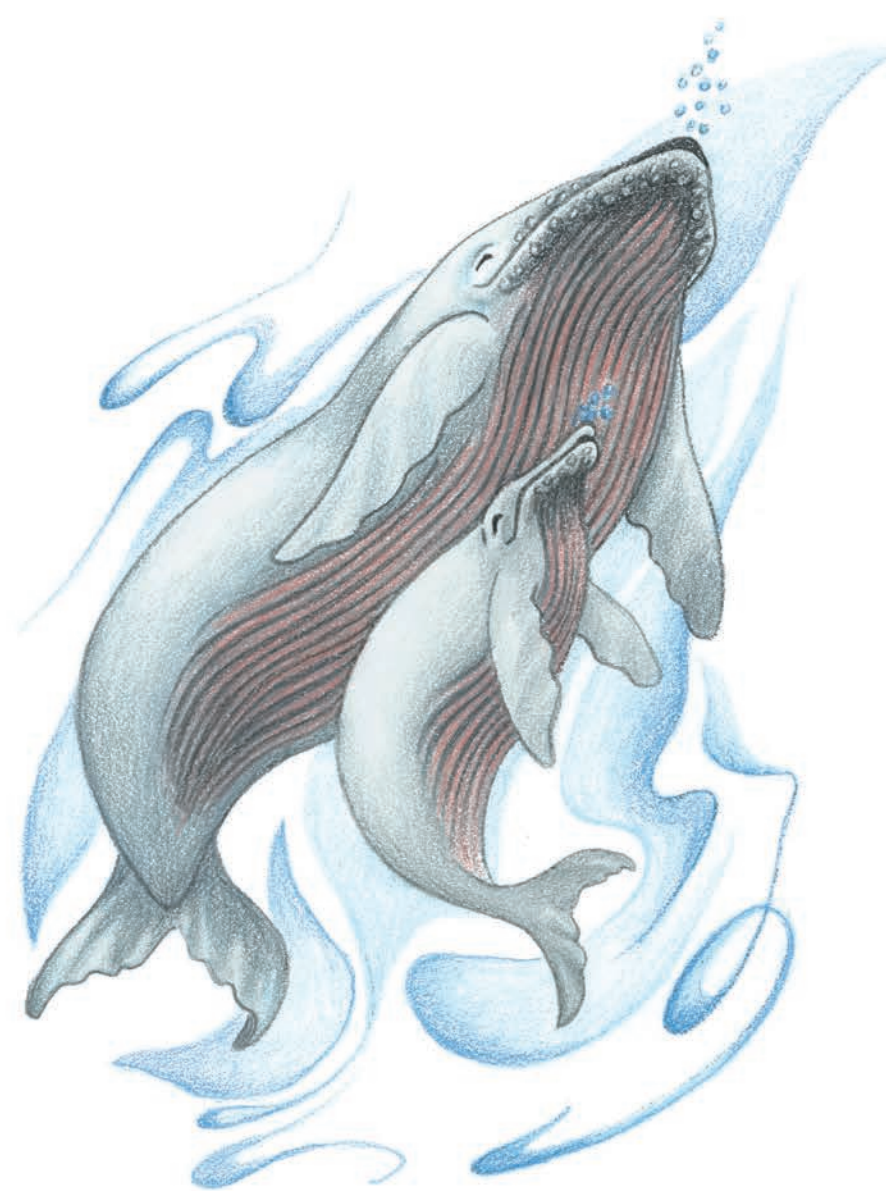


“What can we do?” said Tang.
