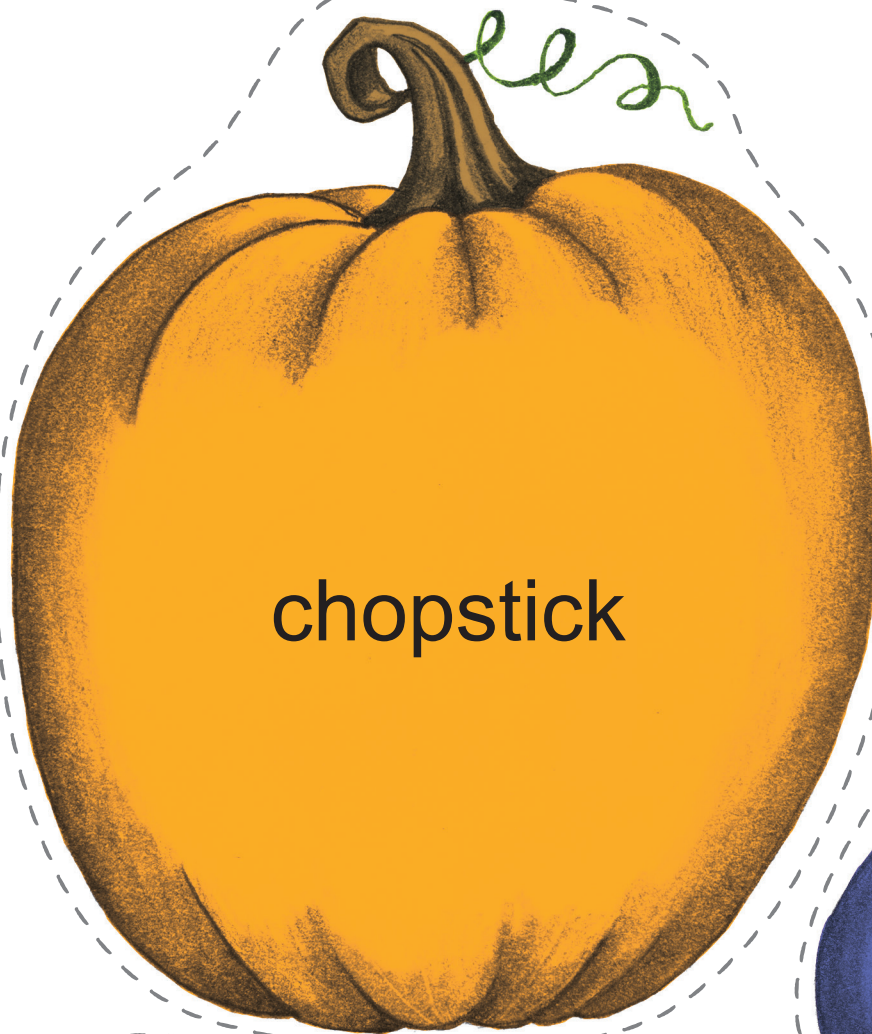
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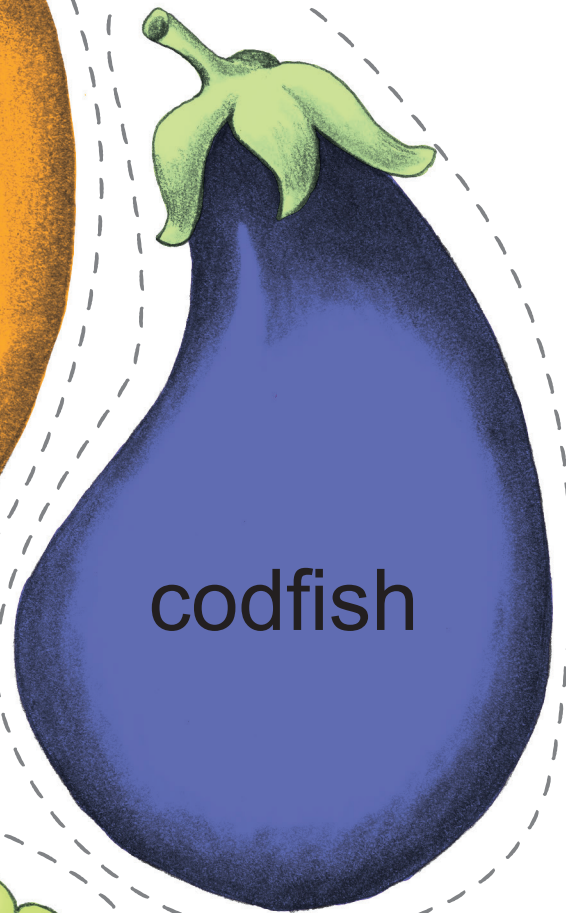
Compound words are special words that are made up of two smaller words, such as *sandbox*. This activity gives your child an opportunity to visualize how a compound word can be divided into two smaller words.

## **Instructions**

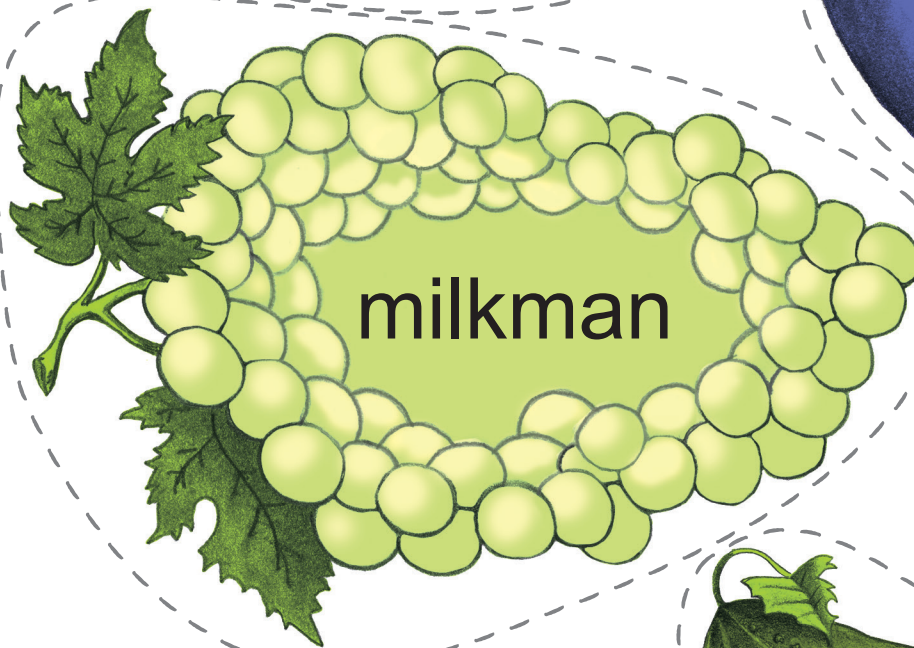
1. Print pages 2-3 of this activity.

4. Encourage your child to read each smaller word and then the entire compound word.



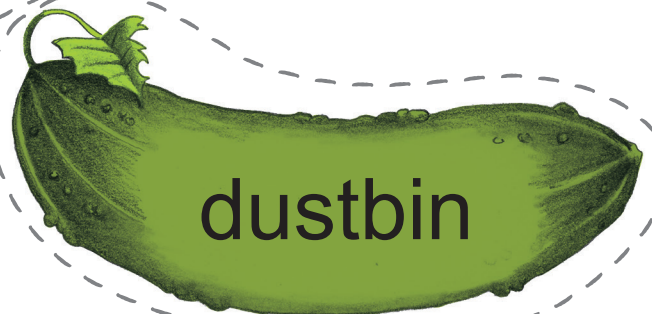
