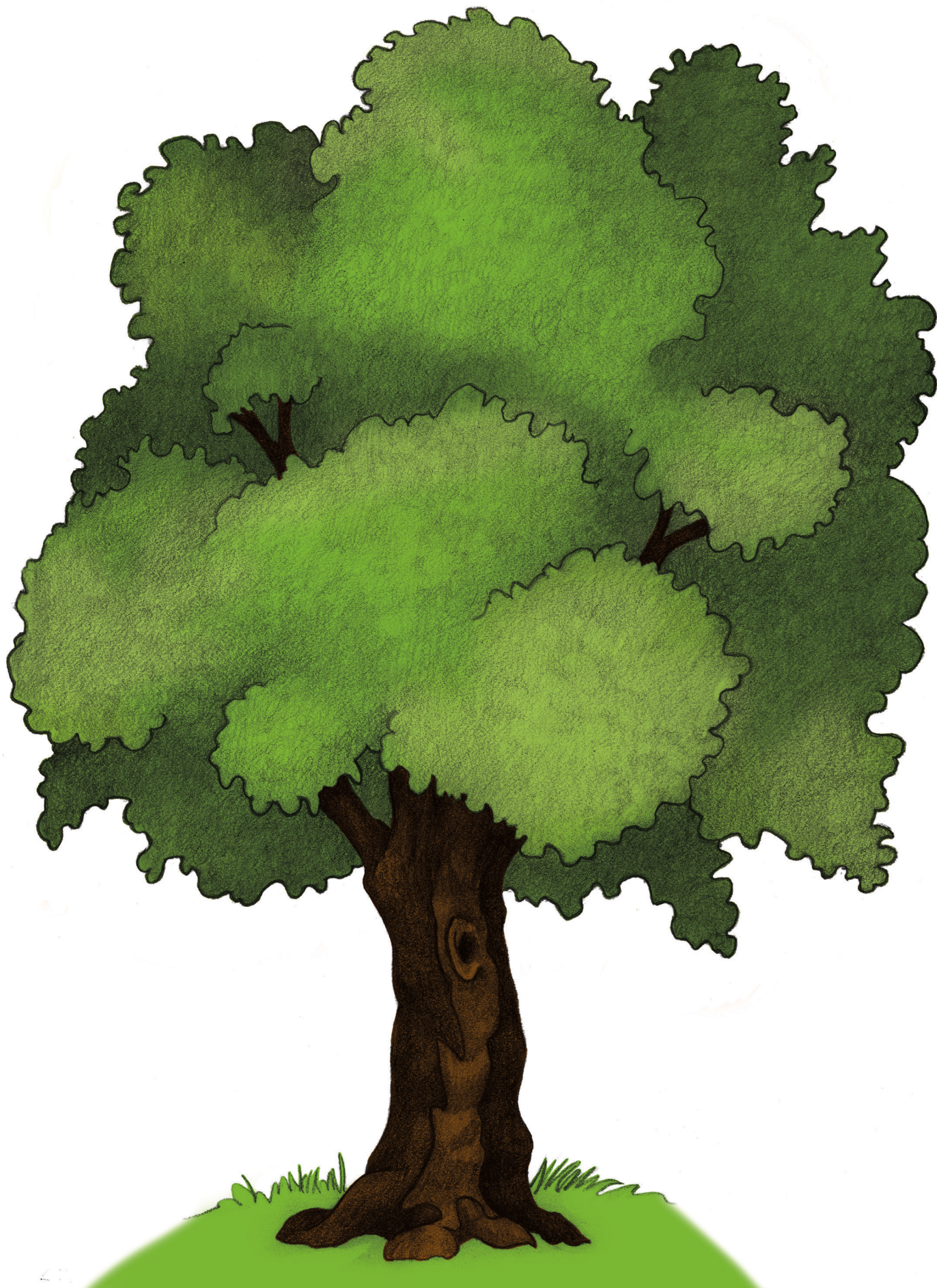
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A vowel at the end of a syllable is usually long. For example, listen for the long vowel sounds in the following words: *hero*, *hi*, *music*. In this activity, your student will practice reading words with long vowels at the end of syllables.

Instructions

1. Print pages 4-5 of this activity back to back.
2. Cut out the mother cat and twelve kitten cards. Your student may color the cards and tree, if desired.
3. Place the kitten cards on the tree with the words facing down.
4. Have your student choose a card and read the word aloud. If he reads the word correctly, he can “rescue” the kitten by returning it to the mother cat. If he reads the word incorrectly, return the kitten card to the tree for another try.
5. Continue until all the kittens have been happily reunited with their mother.
