





Clip, Clop, Crack!

Pop, moo, meow, tweet—these are all examples of *onomatopoeia*. Onomatopoeia is when words imitate sound. Let's practice reading more words that imitate sounds!

Prepare the Activity

- 1. Print pages 3-4.
- 2. Cut out the word cards on page 4 and spread them out on the table with the words facing up.



How to Play

- 1. Have your student match each word with the drawing that makes that sound. For example, "clip-clop, clip-clop" should be matched with the drawing of the walking horse.
- 2. Continue until all word cards have been matched to their illustrations.


