

Instructions

- 1. Print pages 4-5 of this activity back to back.
- 2. Cut out the word cards and the pan for the gold.
- 3. Place the rectangular word cards along the river with the words facing down.
- 4. Have your student select a card from the river and read the word aloud. If he reads the word correctly, he may add the "gold" to his pan. If he reads the word incorrectly, return the card to the river for another try.
- 5. Continue until your student has all the "gold" in his pan.
