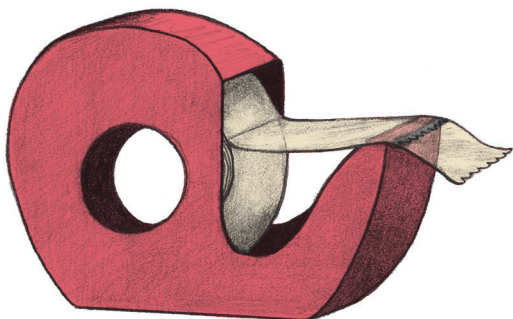
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In many words, Silent E makes the previous vowel long, as in *tape*, *shine*, and *code*. In this activity, your student will practice reading words with Silent E.

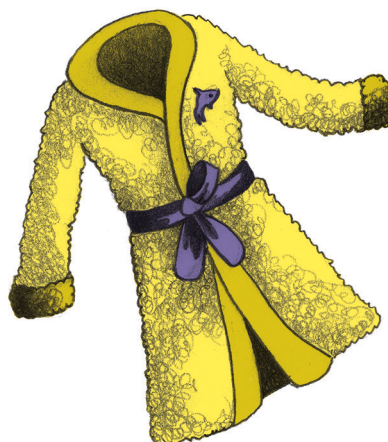
