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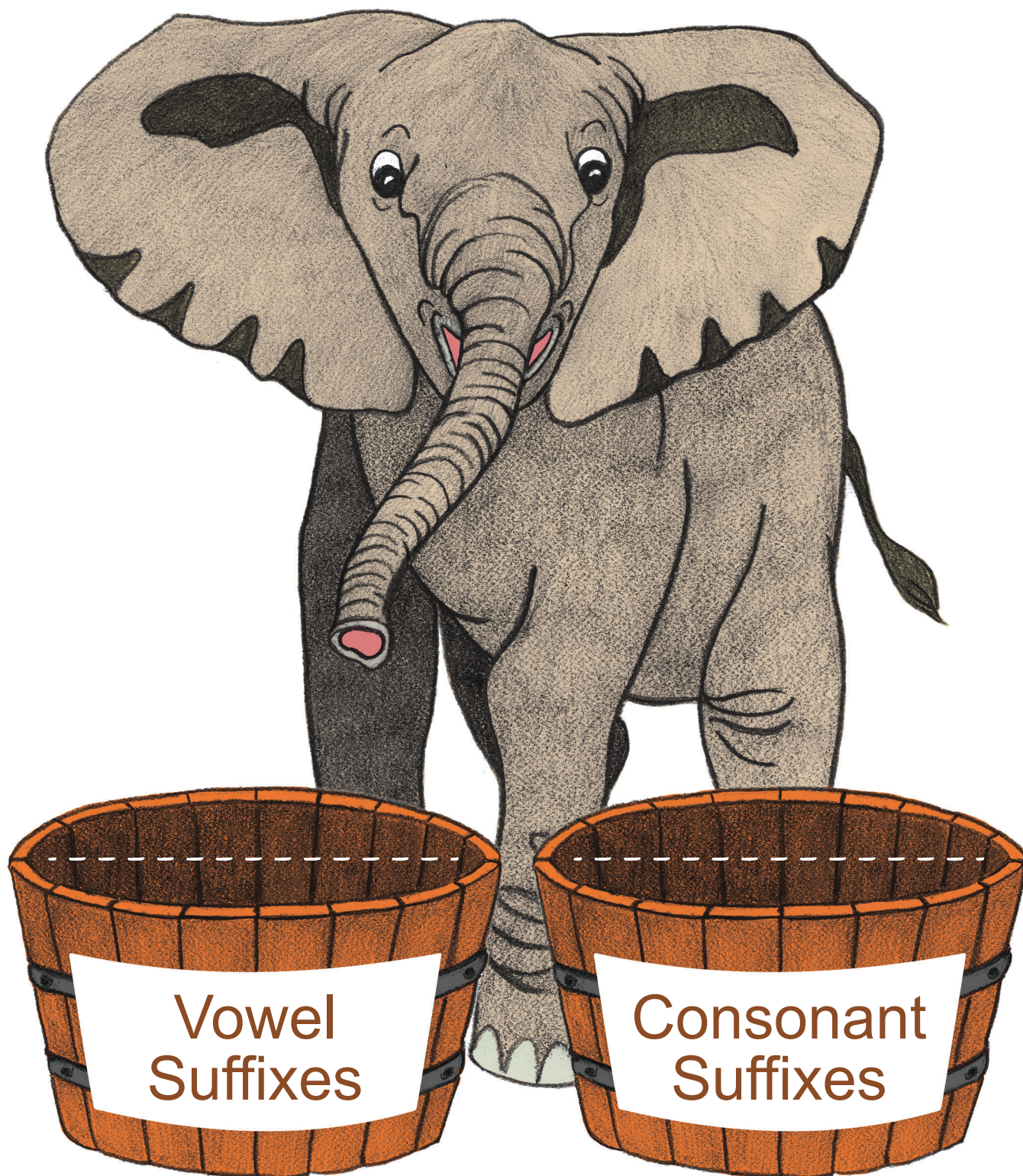
This endearing elephant is here to help your child learn about suffixes! In this activity, your child will sort vowel and consonant suffixes into separate containers and gain important practice in recognizing suffixes.

Instructions

1. Cut along the dotted line on each bucket on page 3.
2. Cut out the peanuts on page 4.
3. Mix up the peanuts and place them in a pile with the peanuts facing up.
4. Have your child pick one peanut at a time and decide whether it is a vowel suffix or a consonant suffix.
5. If the suffix is identified correctly, have your child put it in the appropriate bucket for the elephant. If the suffix is identified incorrectly, return it to the bottom of the pile so your child can try again later. Continue until all the peanuts have been happily eaten by the hungry elephant.
