## **Dinner Time**

## **Instructions**

- 1. Print pages 3-4 (color version) or page 5-6 (black-and-white version).
- 2. Cut out the place setting and the illustrated food cards. Place them on the table with the illustrations facing up.
- 3. Point at the pickle card and say, "It's dinner time, and I'm hungry! Please pass the *tickle*."
- 4. Allow your child to correct you ("No, it's a *pickle*!") and then encourage her to place the appropriate food card on the dinner plate.
- 5. Feel free to get silly with this activity and invent nonsense words as you play. Here are a few ideas to get you started!

apple / mapple spaghetti / basghetti


cake / glake jam / plam


carrot / blarrot hamburger / scramburger


pancake / cancake tomato / dromato


broccoli / croccoli pickle / blickle
