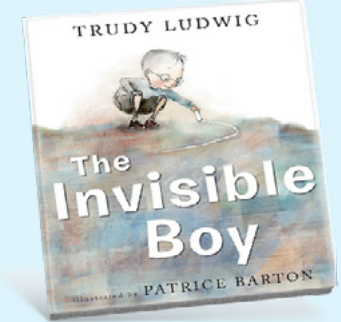
One Smile by Cindy McKinley
