#### **Instructions**

- 1. Print pages 3-4 and 5-6 back to back. If you prefer, you can glue or tape the playing cards together.
- 2. Cut out the ducks. Place the adult duck cards in a pile and arrange the baby duck cards in the pond.
- 3. Have your student select an adult duck card and read the word aloud. Then have him choose a baby duck card and read the word aloud. If he reads the word correctly, reunite the baby duck with its parent. If he reads the word incorrectly, return the baby duck to the pond for another try.
- 4. Continue until all the ducks have been reunited with their babies.
- 5. Customize the last page with the words of your choice and repeat the activity.

#### **Optional**

Match up the rhyming pairs of adult and baby duck cards.
