# Feed the Anteater

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This anteater is hungry! In this activity, your child will feed the anteater while reviewing words from *All About Reading* Level 2.

## **Instructions**

1. Cut two slits on the anteater as indicated by the dotted lines. Cut apart the word strips on the dotted lines.
2. Take one of the word strips and weave it through the slits as indicated by the arrow. (The words will appear on the front of the anteater activity.) Pull the slip up from the back, so one word is revealed at a time. Have your student read the word aloud, then pull up the slip to reveal the next word. You can also make longer word strips by taping several of them together.
3. Continue until the anteater has “eaten” all the ants on the word strips.
4. Customize page 6 with the words of your choice and repeat the activity.
