- 1) Print page 3



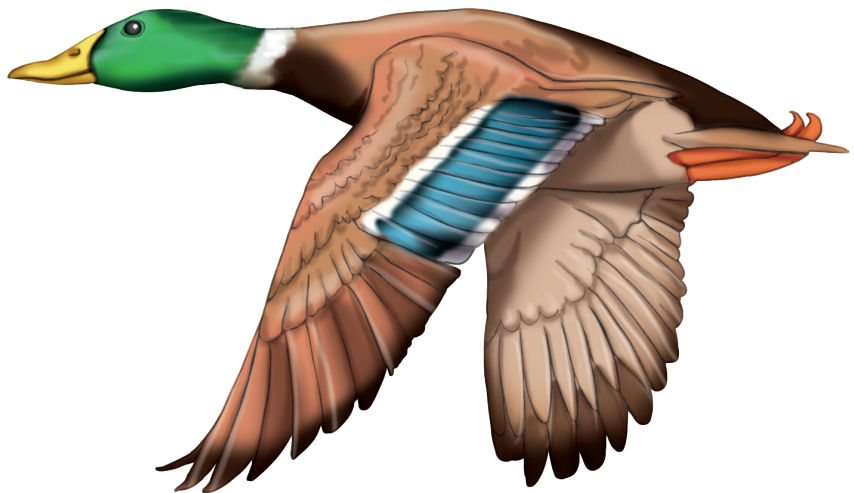
Instructions for Spelling Practice

- 1) One at a time, have your student look at each object and decide whether the word ends in ck or k. The student should then write the letters on the line provided. If the word ends in ck, your student can quack like a duck.
- 2) If necessary, remind your student that ck is used only if the letter immediately before it is a short vowel.

Answer Key

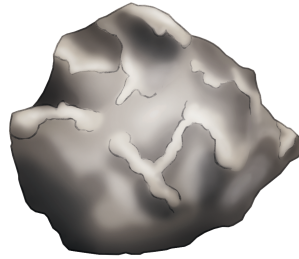
ck: clock, rock, truck, lock, neck

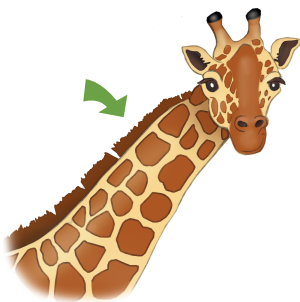
